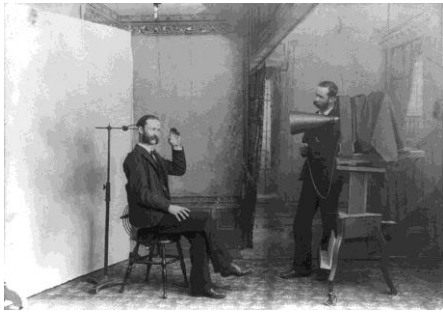

SESSION OUTLINE

ABSTRACT
